Day visitors will begin their jamboree experience at the Info Centre of Kander 100 located in the Campsite Entrance of our Centre.

Visitors will be given an ID which will allow you to walk through the campsite. Tickets will be available for sale at the Info Center if you haven't purchased tickets ahead of your visit.

What can visitors see?

Visitors are able to move freely through the Kander 100 campsite. This area is the heart of the jamboree and includes rich programming, engaging exhibits, and opportunities for cultural exchanges.

Visitors have access to the following places, according to the day's capacity:

Programme:

- Global Goals Exhibition: visit this all-in-one dynamic place to discover how
 Scouts are creating positive change around the world with local projects and
 international networks, through fun and engaging activities. The Exhibition
 welcomes you to explore the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals.
- Workshops: participate in these activities to learn Scouting and life skills.
- Pop Up activities: participate in these activities focused on teamwork, and social and personal leadership development.
- Social café: for young people below 18 years old. Visit this area to meet other young people. The area will be offering drinks and snacks.
- Adult's Social area: for adults over 18 years old. Visit this area to relax after a
 long day, enjoy some time off and meet other contingent/group leaders. The area
 will have a cafe, offering drinks and snacks.
- Challenge Activities: join these activities to try zip-wiring, crate stacking and climbing up an outdoor ladder.
- Spiritual Development: visit the chapel for connecting the nature of spirituality to bring people together.
- **Ceremonies:** if you are visiting one of the days we have ceremonies, you will be able to join as well.

All of our activities are suitable for any skill set (beginner to expert). At each activity, you will receive of the help you need to start having fun right away.

You will have access to the KISC shop to purchase souvenirs items and other Scout merchandises, together with drinks and snacks.
