



Roverway is an international scout camp for Rovers (aged 16 to 22) from all over Europe. The camp is usually structured around two parts: the “Paths” and a main camp. The last Roverway took place in Norway in 2024 and lasted eleven days. Around 5 500 scouts took part in it.

In 2028, it is planned to take place in Switzerland. That is why we are looking for a

Co-Lead Support Division

to co-lead the Support Division of Roverway 2028 together with the current Division Lead. The Support Division brings together a wide range of cross-cutting topics that are essential to the whole camp: Sustainability, IT, Legal, Insurance and Merchandising. The Co-Lead shares the strategic, operational and people responsibility of the division with the other co-lead division. Your responsibilities will be the following:

- Define and shape the overall strategy of the Support Division together with the other co-lead division
- Co-lead the division (Sustainability, IT, Legal, Insurance, Merchandising) and ensure the coordination and coherence of its different domains
- Co-coordinate the Support team and create the conditions for each lead to deliver successfully
- Represent the Support Division at the monthly meetings with all division leads and the camp directors,
- Ensure smooth interfaces between the Support Division and all the other divisions (Communication, Programme, Logistics, People, Finance, Medical Services & Security)
- Co-build and monitor the division's roadmap, milestones and deliverables
- Co-build and monitor the Support Division budget, in close coordination with the Finance division
- Support the recruitment, onboarding and follow-up of the leads within the division
- Act as a sparring partner for each lead on strategic, operational and people topics
- Step in when needed to back up a lead or temporarily cover a gap
- Contribute to risk identification and mitigation across the division's topics
- Document and pass on the Support Division's organisation and learnings to future Roverway editions

Here is what awaits you:

- Meetings with all division leads and the camp directors
- 2 meetings per month with the Support team. Frequency will increase as we get closer to the event.
- Regular meetings with the other co-lead division
- Approx. 8 to 10 hours of voluntary work per week
- Designing and shaping the strategy and organisation of the Support Division
- Close collaboration with all the leads of the division and all the other divisions of Roverway 2028
- Opportunity to bring in and develop your know-how on a large-scale, multi-stakeholder project
- Collaboration with international contacts (WOSM, WAGGGS and other scout events)



- Development of your network at both national and international levels
- Making an international scouting experience possible for approx. 5000 participants and approx. 1000 volunteers

What you bring:

- Time, energy and motivation for a multi-year commitment
- A taste for shared leadership and collaboration
- A systemic vision and the ability to think strategically and transversally
- Experience in leading teams or projects, ideally in a complex or multi-stakeholder environment
- Sensitivity to people management and the ability to support and challenge team members constructively
- Ability to navigate ambiguity and to make decisions with incomplete information
- Skills or strong interest in one or more of the Support Division's domains (sustainability, IT, legal, insurance, merchandising) is an asset
- Experience in event management is an asset
- Ability to keep an overall view of a complex, multi-stakeholder project
- Good command of English and one Swiss national language (French, German or Italian)
