



Roverway is an international Guides and Scouts camp for Rovers (aged 16 to 22) from all over Europe. The camp typically consists of two parts: the Paths, where the participants explore Switzerland in smaller groups of around 70 people, and a main camp. The last Roverway took place in Norway in 2024 and lasted eleven days. Approximately 5500 Guides and Scouts participated. The next Roverway is scheduled to take place in Switzerland in 2028. That is why we are looking for a:

Crisis Communication Team Member

Big and small crises are part of life. We Scouts are experts at handling these crises professionally. For Roverway too, we'll be building our own team for this. You develop a communication strategy and support the crisis team's communications. Overall leadership of crisis management lies with the Main Camp management – you bring your professional experience or your experience from Scout crisis teams and help ensure that communication is clear and consistent in an emergency. As communication specialist on the crisis team, you're a member of the "Public Relations" department within the Communication Division (see organizational chart).

What you can expect:

- Check-in as agreed with your Division Leads (approx. every 4 months)
- Approx. 2h of volunteer work per month (more from 2028 onward)
- The opportunity to contribute and further develop your know-how
- Collaboration with international contacts (including within your division crew)
- Expanding your network on a national and international level
- Helping make possible an international Scouting experience for approx. 5000 participants and approx. 1000 volunteers

What you bring to table:

- Time, enthusiasm and motivation for a multi-year commitment
- Experience in Scout crisis teams or similar structures
- Calm and reliability in stressful situations
- Experience in public relations
- Good language skills (English, German or French)

What we need from you:

- Your resume (including your Guiding and Scouting career as well as on Guiding and Scouting reference)
- A short motivation letter answering the following questions (an email is fine)
 - What interests you about this project?
 - Why are you the right person for this division?
