You will develop and implement the program concepts for the Main Camp together with an international Team. This includes mainly the planning and execution of sporty, social, cultural and spiritual activities on and off the main camp site. You will enable for over 5000 participant an unforgettable camp and personal development for their lives at home.

- The opportunity to contribute your expertise and develop your skills
- Collaboration with international contacts
- Expansion of your network at the national and international levels
- Helping to create an international Guiding and Scouting experience for approx. 5000 participants and approx. 1000 volunteers
